BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TORRANCE COUNTY, NEW MEXICO RESOLUTION NO. <u>95-36</u> GOVERNING SMALL PURCHASES

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Board of Commissioners, Torrance County, New Mexico, deem it prudent to amend the existing Resolution #84–13, Torrance County Procurement Regulations, by changing the existing wording as follows:

6. ISSUANCE OF PURCHASE

In the event the Central Purchasing Office determines not to approve a Requisition and not to issue a Purchase Order, it may submit the matter to the County Manager for <u>his</u> / her review, and at the discretion of the County Manager, the matter may be submitted to the County Commission.


8. <u>EMERGENCY PURCHASES</u>

An emergency purchase is made only when a threat exists to the public health, <u>safety and general welfare of the residents of Torrance County</u>. No purchase order shall be issued for an emergency purchase without the written approval of the County Manager. DELETE: and at least one County Commissioner.

10. DEADLINE ON ALL DISBURSEMENTS

Deadline for submissions of invoices for payment will be every <u>Friday</u>, 5:00 <u>P.M.</u>, prior to a regularly scheduled County Commission Meeting.
