Resolution No. <u>97-2</u>

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Board of County Commissioners met in regular session at the Torrance County Courthouse on January 8, 1997 at 9:00 A.M. as required by law; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(B) of the Open Meetings Act (NMSA 1978, Sections 10-15-1 to -4) states that, except as may be otherwise provided in the Constitution or otherwise provided in the Constitution of the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, all meetings of a quorum of members of any board, councils, commissions, administrative adjudicatory body of other policy making body of any state or local public agency held for the purpose of formulating public policy, discussing public business or for the purpose of taking any action within the authority of or the delegated authority of such body, are declared to be public meetings open to the public at all times; and

WHEREAS, any meetings subject to the Open Meetings Act at which the discussion or adoption of any proposed resolution, rule, regulation or formal action occurs shall be held only after reasonable notice to the public; and

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) of the Open Meetings Act requires the Torrance County Commission to determine annually what constitutes reasonable notice of its public meetings;

NOW, THERFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Torrance County Commission:

- 1. All meetings shall be held at the Torrance County Courthouse at 9:00 A.M. or as indicated in the meeting notice.
- 2. Unless otherwise specified, regular meetings shall be held twice a month on the second and forth Wednesday. The agenda will be available at least twenty-four hours prior to the meeting from the County Manager, whose office is located in Estancia, New Mexico. Notice of any other regular meetings will be given ten days in advance of the meeting date. The notice shall indicate how a copy of the agenda may be obtained.
- 3. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman or a majority of the members upon twenty-four hour notice. The notice shall include an agenda for the meeting or information on how members of the public may obtain a copy of the agenda. The agenda shall be available to the public at least four hours before any special meeting.

- Following completion of any closed meeting, the minutes of the open (c) meeting that was closed, or the minutes of the next open meeting if the closed meeting was separately scheduled, shall state whether the matters discussed in the closed meeting were limited only to those specified in the motion or notice for closure.
- Except as provided in Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings Act, any (d) action taken as a result of discussions in a closed meeting shall be made by vote of the Torrance County Board of Commissioners in an open meeting.
