## Torrance County Senior Citizen Program

## Narrative

We come to this area plan realizing that Torrance County estimated costs for the 2001-2002 fiscal year are in excess of \$255,000. In addition the County has expended considerable time assisting the Senior Department staff in preparation of reports and other organizational work. Other costs such as insurance and routine maintenance are covered by the County as well.

Consideration of the budget displayed on AAA forms rises from the following budget worksheets developed by Senior Volunteer Bill Miller and staff of Torrance Senior program.

We cannot continue the program with the 2002-2003 allocation. This area plan and budget reflect the following changes:

1. Propose to close the Willard Center.

2. Propose to close the McIntosh Center.

3. Reduce phone charges.

4. Reduce transportation expenses to reimbursable levels.
