RESOLUTION SUPPORTING NEW MEXICO COUNTIES' 2024 LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES

9	WHEREAS, in August 2023, the New Mexico Counties (NMC) Board of			
10	Directors approved three legislative priorities for consideration by the New Mexico			
11	Legislature at its 2024 session; and			
12				
13	WHEREAS, NMC has requested that the Board of County Commissioners in each			
14 15	of the state's 33 counties discuss and approve support for NMC's legislative priorities as an important step in assuring maximum understanding of NMC's			
16	legislative priorities at the county level; and			
17				
18 19	WHEREAS, county support enables NMC to demonstrate strong local and statewide support to the state legislature for the following issues:			
20				
21	1. HB 2 Appropriations			
22				
23	Detention Reimbursement Fund			
24	Fully fund County Detention Facilities Reimbursement Act Fund to reimburse			
25	counties for the actual cost of housing state inmates.			
26				
27	• Currently at \$5 million			
28	 According to the New Mexico Sentencing Commission, the five-year 			
29	average cost to house New Mexico Corrections Department inmates is \$7.5			
30	million.			
31				
32	Detention Recruitment and Retention			
33	Appropriate \$10 million to the newly formed Corrections Workforce Capacity			
34	Building Fund administered by DFA.			
35				
36	• Sufficient numbers of detention staff are essential to a safe and well-			
37	operated detention facility which is directly correlated to community safety.			
38	• A public safety recruitment and retention fund would provide local			
39 40	governments with much needed resources to provide detention services to their communities.

2	Prisoner Transport and Extradition			
3	Create a line item in the DFA budget with \$750,000 to reimburse counties that			
4	provide transportation for state prisoners.			
5				
б	• Statute 4-44-18C NMSA requires the state to make such payment.			
7	• Counties should not be responsible to pay for state prisoner extradition.			
8	e contraction de les ponsione de pay foi state prisoner extraction.			
9	RISE Funding			
10	Make permanent and increase county participation in the RISE (Reach,			
11	Intervene, Support and Engage) Program.			
12				
13	Emergency Medical Services			
14	Create a line item in the Department of Health Emergency Medical Services			
15	(EMS) Bureau budget with \$10 million to assist local government EMS services.			
16				
17	• Emergency medical services in New Mexico have been significantly			
18	underfunded for years.			
19	• Current state appropriations, taxes collected through local GRT increments,			
20	and other sources of revenue do not provide sufficient support to local			
21	governments to meet community needs, especially in rural areas of the state.			
22	• EMS services are vital to the health and welfare of New Mexico citizens.			
23				
24	Courthouse Funding			
25	Create a recurring appropriation of \$25 million for construction and renovation			
26	of state district courthouses.			
27				
28	• In 2023, the legislature appropriated \$23 million to the Administrative			
29	Office of the Courts to assist with critical needs.			
30	• \$15 million was designated to resolve litigation between the 8 th Judicial			
31	District Court and Otero County and the remaining balance is being			
32	distributed based on needs statewide.			
33	• Counties maintain that district courthouses are a state responsibility and that			
34	the rising costs of construction, security, and IT necessitate a shared revenue			
35	stream.

37	State Health Benefits Plan			
38	Create a State Health Benefit Fund solvency plan.

1 2	• The current State Health Care Benefit Plan is facing an estimated \$149 million deficit.			
2 3	 The State of New Mexico has not increased premiums in the past three 			
4	years.			
5	• The General Services Division invoiced local government public bodies			
6	(LPB) for approximately \$18 million for previous and projected shortfalls.			
7 8	• NMC has filed a lawsuit on behalf of 24 counties questioning the legality of these "special assessments."			
9	• NMC seeks a solution to ensure fund solvency and guarantee proper notice			
10	and planning to enable LPBs to adequately budget for increased cost moving			
11	forward.			
12	2. Elected Official Salary Increase			
13				
14	Increase the salary cap for newly elected county officials by 15% with a			
15	provision for future adjustments to track the Consumer Price Index (CPI).			
16				
17	• Last amended in 2018 (HB69) for increases beginning in 2019.			
18	 Historically adjusted approximately every 4 years. 			
19	• Must be in place when newly elected officials take office in 2024.			
20	• CPI provision would eliminate the need for repeated legislative action.			
21 22	3. Firefighter Recruitment & Retention			
22	5. Phengheir Recruitment & Retention			
23 24	Appropriate a \$50 million reoccurring fund to the NM Department of Homeland			
25	Security to be administered by the State Fire Marshal's Office for fire			
26	departments to staff, recruit, and retain career and volunteer firefighters.			
27				
28	• Call volume has increased by as much as 50% in the last year.			
29	• Response systems are overburdened.			
30	• Average age of New Mexican volunteer is 65.			
31				
32	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Torrance County Board of			
33	County Commissioners does hereby support NMC's legislative priorities as set			
34	forth above and urges that legislation incorporating these priorities be enacted by			
35	the state legislature during its 2024 session.
