TORRANCE COUNTY ORDINANCE # 93-8

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE OBTAINING AND DISPLAYING OF RURAL
ADDRESSES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF TORRANCE
COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

An ordinance adopting the Mile Marker System of rural
addressing, requiring the owners and occupants of every house
and building in the unincorporated areas of Torrance County to
display the house numbers assigned, and providing a penalty for
failure to do so.

Numbers of Buildings: It shall be the duty of the owner and
occupants of every house and building in the above described
unincorporated portion of Torrance County to have placed upon
their property, in a location visible from the road upon which
such house or building fronts or is provided access, figures at
least three(3) inches high, showing the number of the house or
building. Any person, firm or corporation failing to so number
any house or building owned or occupied by it, shall be subject
to a fine of \$5(five dollars) for each day during or on which a
failure to do so continues, not to exceed \$25.00 per offense.
