## DECISION ORDER NO. 3822(a)

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter.

## CONCLUSIONS OF IAW

- 1. The evidence and testimony presented by the Petitioner justifies the rate increase requested by the Applicant.
- The proposed increase is necessary for the continued economic and safe operation of the applicant in service and to the general public of New Mexico.
