TORRANCE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION NO. 14

A RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING AN ADDITIONAL 3 MILLS PER THOUSAND DOLLARS OF TAXABLE VALUE FOR COUNTY OPERATIONAL EXPENSES

WHEREAS, New Mexico Statutes Annotated, Section 4-38-17 authorizes the Torrance County Commission to set millage rates to fund the operations and services provided by County government subject to statutory and constitutional limitations; and

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Commission wishes to authorize an additional 3 mill levy per thousand dollars of taxable value, with such millage rate being with the aforementioned statutory and constitutional limitations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Torrance County Commission that the millage rate for operation of Torrance County government shall be and hereby is increased an additional 3 mills per one thousand dollars of taxable value, said millage rate being effective beginning in the 1987-88 fiscal year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Torrance County Commission will utilize two of the additional three mills for maintenance and construction of Torrance County roads provided further, that the dedication of two mills for road maintenance and construction shall be a limitation upon the Commission to expend the monies only for purposes of maintenance and construction of County roadways.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Torrance County Commission will utilize one of the additional three mills for a social service fund to subsidize social programs in Torrance County, however, that dedication of one mill for social programs shall not be a limitation upon the Commission to expend the monies for purposes other then funding social programs if circumstances require the monies be spent otherwise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the increase in millage levy shall be effective until rescinded or modified by the Torrance County Commission and the Commission retains the authority to modify the levy in whole or in part.
