

TORRANCE COUNTY RESOLUTION # $\frac{4}{7}$

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Commission finds that the following resolution is necessary to protect the health, safety, and economic well-being of the citizens of Torrance County; and

WHEREAS, The Torrance County Commission finds that a well coordinated county wide program of soil and water conservation is vital to Torrance County; and

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Commission finds that this resolution is necessary to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the morals, order, comfort and convenience of the county and its citizens;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Torrance County Commission as follows:

- 1. Torrance County is highly dependant on agriculture and livestock production; and
- 2. The three (3) Soil and Water Conservation districts located in Torrance County are a vital part of these industries; and
- Closure of any of the support SCS Field offices would have significant negative impact on existing and future projects, and the economy of Torrance County; and
- 4. Combining any two (2) of these field offices would create hardships on citizens of Torrance County who are dependant on agriculture and livestock for their livelihood; and
- 5. The Torrance County Commission strongly opposes the closure of any SCS office in Torrance County, or reduction in personnel.
