



RESOLUTION 2006 -50

**Support for the Town of Edgewood, the City of Moriarty and the Moriarty School District Board of Education Shared Concern About Closure at Two Moriarty School District Schools**

Whereas, there is a possibility of closure at two Moriarty School District Schools; and

Whereas, the problem is a budget shortfall due to the loss of student enrollments; and

Whereas, the Town of Edgewood, the City of Moriarty and the Moriarty School District Board of Education are concerned about these possible closures, and Torrance County shares their concern;

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved that the Governing Body of Torrance County supports the Town of Edgewood's request of the appointment of a Committee, with representation from the Town of Edgewood governing body, the City of Moriarty governing body and the Moriarty School District Board of Education, whose purview will be to develop short-term and long-term strategies in an attempt to preclude the need for school closures.

Be It Further Resolved with total support from Torrance County, that the proposed strategies to be addressed will include, but not be limited, to:

- Meeting with elected and/or appointed State of New Mexico Officials;
- Consider factors that tend to limit growth and workforce housing development;
- To promote a united effort to seek changes in New Mexico Statutes that negatively impact rural K-12 funding; and
- To develop an overall strategy to insure that rural economic development will remain viable within the Moriarty School District.

**Agreement Related to Costs Incurred to Obtain Commercial Driver's License**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby acknowledge that as a condition of my employment by the Torrance County Road Department as an equipment operator, agree as follows:

1. I am required by Torrance County policy to obtain a commercial driver's license to continue employment with the Torrance County Road Department.
  - a. As a probationary employee, I understand the demand and expectation of and, to the best of my knowledge, I believe I can obtain the Class A Commercial Driver's License within my six-month probationary period. I am in complete understanding of the fact that if I do not obtain my CDL within the six-month time limit, I can no longer be employed by the Torrance County Road Department and am subject to automatic termination.
2. Torrance County will incur substantial costs, including, but not limited to, the cost of the driver test and the instructor's travel expenses, to aid me in obtaining my commercial driver's license.
3. In the event I leave my employment with the Torrance County Road Department within one year after obtaining my commercial driver's license, I agree that I will reimburse Torrance County for all funds expended, including, but not limited to, the driver test and the instructor's travel expenses, in aiding me to obtain my commercial driver's license.
4. I further agree and instruct the Torrance County payroll department to withhold the above reimbursement from my final paycheck from Torrance County after my separation from employment.
