TRI- COUNTY JUVENILE JUSTICE BOARD RESOLUTION 2012- 3/ OPEN MEETINGS ACT

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Commission did, on February 10, 2010, establish the Torrance County Juvenile Justice Board; and did on September 12, 2012 appoint the Tri-County Juvenile Justice Board for FY 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Tri- County Juvenile Justice Board shall comply with the Open Meetings Act; and,

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(B) of the Open Meetings Act (NMSA 1978, Sections 10-15-1 to -4) states that, except as may be otherwise provided in the Constitution or otherwise provided in the Constitution of the provisions of the Open Meetings Act, all meetings of a quorum of members of any board, council, commission, administrative adjudicatory body or other policy making body of any state or local public agency held for the purpose of formulating public policy, discussing public business or for the purpose of taking any action within the authority of or the delegated authority of such body, are declared to be public meetings open to the public at all times; and,

WHEREAS, any meetings subject to the Open Meetings Act at which the discussion or adoption of any proposed resolution, rule, regulation, or formal action occurs shall be held only after reasonable notice to the public; and,

WHEREAS, Section 10-15-1(D) of the Open Meetings Act requires the Tri-County Juvenile Justice Board to determine annually what constitutes reasonable notice of its public meetings;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Torrance County Juvenile Justice Board:

- 1. All meetings shall be held at the Torrance County District Court at 3:30 p.m. on the fourth (4th) Tuesday of the month or as indicated in the meeting notice
- 2. Meeting agendas will be available at least seventy-two (72) hours prior to the meeting from the TCJJB Board Coordinator, whose office is located in Moriarty, New Mexico. The notice shall indicate how a copy of the agenda may be obtained.
- 3. Special meetings may be called by the Chair or a majority of the members upon twenty-four (24) hours notice. The notice shall include an agenda for the meeting or information on how members of the public may obtain a copy of the agenda. The agenda shall be available to the public at least twenty-four (24) hours before any special meeting.
- 4. For the purposes of regular meetings described in paragraph 2 of the resolution and special meetings described in paragraph 3 of the resolution, notice requirements are met if notice of the date, time, place and agenda is posted in the Torrance County Courthouse and on the Torrance County website.
- 5. In addition to the information specified above, all notices shall include the following language: "If you are an individual with a disability who is in need of a reader, amplifier, qualified sign language interpreter, or any other form of auxiliary aid or service to attend or participate in the hearing or meeting, please contact the Torrance County Manager's Office at 205 9th Street, Room 24, Estancia, NM 87016; 505-246-4752 at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the meeting or as soon as possible". Public documents, including the agenda and minutes, can be provided in various accessible formats. Please contact the TCJJB Coordinator if a summary or other type of accessible format is needed.

- 6. The Tri- County Juvenile Justice Board may close a meeting to the public only if the subject matter of such discussion or action is exempted from the open meeting requirement under Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings Act.
 - a. If any meeting is closed during an open meeting, such closure shall be approved by a majority vote of a quorum of the Tri-County Juvenile Justice Board taken during the open meeting. The authority for the closure and the subjects to be discussed shall be stated with reasonable specificity in the motion to close and the both of each individual member on the motion to close shall be recorded in the minutes. Only those subjects specified in the motion may be discussed in a closed meeting.
 - b. If the decision to hold a closed meeting is made when the Tri-County Juvenile Justice Board is not in an open meeting, the closed meeting shall not be held until public notice, appropriate under the circumstances, stating provision of law authorizing the closed meeting and the subjects to be discussed with reasonable specificity is given to the members and to the general public.
 - c. Following completion of any closed meeting, the minutes of the open meeting that was closed, or the minutes of the next open meeting if the closed meeting was separately scheduled, shall state whether the matters discussed in the closed meetings were limited only to those specified in the motion or notice for closure.
 - d. Except as provided in Section 10-15-1(H) of the Open Meetings Act, any action taken as a result of discussions in a closed meeting shall be made by vote of the Tri-County Juvenile Justice Board in an open public meeting.
