A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY LOAN APPLICATION TO THE NEW MEXICO BOARD OF FINANCE FOR COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH SOFTWARE AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE RECORDS MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE

WHEREAS, the Torrance County Sheriff's Department and 911 Dispatch are in place to provide for the health, safety and welfare of Torrance County residents as well as visitors; and,

WHEREAS, to provide these extremely important services, the Departments need to have the proper tools to function; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Torrance County Commissioners deem it necessary to purchase a Computer Aided Dispatch Software and Criminal Justice Records Management Software to assist in providing these tools; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the County to purchase this software for these departments; and,

WHEREAS, the County budget cannot sustain such purchase costs at this time, without financial assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of the Torrance County Commission does authorize the submittal of an emergency loan application to the NM State Board of Finance to assist with the purchase of said software;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County will pledge a portion of the High Lonesome Wind PILOT payment to repay the loan.
