1 TORRANCE COUNTY 2 **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSONERS** 3 RESOLUTION NO. 2019-55 4 **Creation of the 2020 Torrance County Complete Count Committee** 5 6 WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by Article I, Section 2 of the U.S. 7 Constitution to conduct an accurate count of the nation's population every ten years; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the U.S. Census Bureau is required by the United States Constitution to 10 11 conduct a count of all persons; and 12 WHEREAS, the Census count requires extensive work, and the Census Bureau requires 13 partners at the state, tribal, and local level to insure a complete and accurate count; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Census data helps determine how many seats each state will have in the 16 U.S. House of Representatives and is necessary for an accurate and fair redistricting of state 17 legislative seats, county and city councils, and voting districts; and 18 19 WHEREAS, federal and state funding is allocated to communities, and decisions are 20 made on matters of national and local importance based, in part, on census data and housing; and 21 22 WHEREAS, information from the 2020 Census and American Community Survey are 23 vital tools for economic development and increased employment; and 24 25 WHEREAS, the information collected by the Census is confidential and protected by 26 law; and 27 28 WHEREAS, a united voice from business, government, community-based, and faith-29 based organizations, educators, health care providers, media and others will enable the New 30 Mexico 2020 Statewide Complete Count Commission message to reach all New Mexicans; and 31 32 WHEREAS, the Torrance County Complete Count Committee will bring together a 33 cross-section of trusted local community members who will utilize their local knowledge and 34 expertise to reach out to all local residents where they are, creating genuine relationships, 35 community buy-in, and trust; and 36 37 WHEREAS, the Torrance County Complete Count Committee will work with the 38 Census Bureau and the New Mexico 2020 Statewide Complete Count Commission to strive for a 39 40 complete and accurate count. 41 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that Torrance County establishes a 2020 42 Census Complete Count Committee. 43 44 45 DONE THIS 25th DAY OF September, 2019.
