4 5 6	EMEREGENCY DECLARATION RELATING TO THE COVID-19 CORONAVIRUS OUTBREAK
7 8	WHEREAS, on January 7th, 2020 the Chinese government confirmed a cluster of cases
9	in Wuhan China were in fact, cases of 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) commonly referred
10	to COVID-19 or Coronavirus; and
11	WHEREAS, by January 21, 2020 the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) had confirmed
12	the first travel related case of COVID-19; and
13	WHEREAS, on March 11th, 2020 the State of New Mexico announced its first three
14	cases of COVID-19; and
15	WHERAS, later that same day, Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham proclaimed a public
16	health emergency and invoked all powers under the All Hazard Emergency Act, NMSA 1978 §
17	12-10-1 through 12-10-10, for a minimum of thirty (30) days; and
18	WHEREAS, by March 17 th , the number of cases had grown to 23 in the State of New
19	Mexico; and
20	WHEREAS, the counties with reported cases include Socorro, Santa Fe, Bernalillo,
21	Sandoval, and Taos counties; and
22	WHEREAS, counties which have confirmed cases of COVID-19 have experienced large
23	increases in requests for Emergency Services (EMS); and
24	WHEREAS, to date, Torrance County has had no reported confirmed cases of COVID-
25	19; and
26	WHEREAS, the public should take all necessary precautions to avoid contact with
27	individuals who may have contracted COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the Torrance County Board of Commissioners to 1 respond to the direct and indirect effects of the COVID-19 crisis in order to protect the health. 2 safety, and welfare of the citizens of Torrance County; 3 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of TORRANCE 4 5 COUNTY that the Torrance County Board of Commissioners does hereby declare Torrance County an emergency area as a result of the COVID-19 virus outbreak pursuant to 6 NMSA 1978 § 12-10-01 through 12-10-21, for the express purpose of exercising necessary 7 emergency powers and expenditure of available resources, and requesting aid, assistance, and 8 relief programs and funds available from the State of New Mexico. 9 10 County departments are hereby directed to utilize County resources and to do everything reasonably possible to assist affected political subdivisions including Moriarty, Estancia, 11 Willard, Encino, Mountainair, and the County's Land Grant communities, in an effort to respond 12 to and recover from the outbreak; and 13 It is the responsibility of Torrance County officials to control County resources and 14 manage and coordinate those resources for the purpose of controlling the spread of COVID-19 15 and maintain public health; and 16 The County Manager may implement all necessary and proper measures to allow for 17 18 flexibility of time and location of work, including for offsite and telecommuting for all employees during the period of this emergency as well as expanding the use of sick leave and 19 unpaid leave where necessary. 20 This Declaration may be adopted by any municipality within the County by resolution. 21 Any such action may include a provision authorizing its mayor or chief executive to take such 22 action regarding its personnel as deemed appropriate by its governing body. 23
