The Torrance County Board of County Commissioners (BOCC) approved submission of an application for the Transportation Project Fund (TPF) for the Spangler Road Improvement Project during its regularly scheduled meeting held March 27, 2024. Torrance County plans to chip seal Spangler Road from HWY 55 and proceed South for 6 miles to HWY 542. Torrance County owns the right of way for the remainder of the road.
