**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF AN
APPLICATION FOR THE 2026-2027 NEW MEXICO
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (NMDOT)
TRANSPORTATION PROJECT FUNDING FOR THE GREENE
ROAD PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Torrance County proposes to rehabilitate/improve one mile of Greene Road located in Moriarty, NM, including drainage improvements, reconstruction and stripping beginning at Old Route 66 and ending at the intersection of Greene Road and Martinez Road; and

WHEREAS, Torrance County acting by its Commission requests \$490,460.70 to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

- a) New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 95% or \$465,952.90;
- b) Torrance County's proportional match share shall be 5% or \$24,523.80; and

WHEREAS, Torrance County assures and certifies that it will comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, funding match requirements and any requirements with respect to the acceptance of NMDOT Transportation Project Funds; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation requests as part of the application procedure the passage and submittal of a local government resolution of support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Torrance County that the Commission hereby endorses and supports the submittal of an application for the Greene Road Project for the FY26 funding cycle in accordance with the procedures established by the New Mexico Department of Transportation.



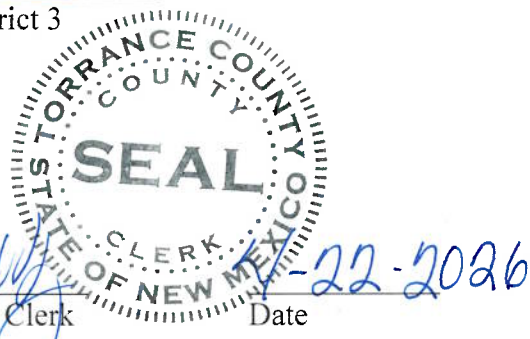
