

Amend the Torrance County Rural Addressing ordinance 97-6 as follows

Replace Section 4 paragraph 3 subparagraph a. With the following

- a. Land developer or subdivider shall submit a proposed list of road names to the County for approval. Developer, subdivider, or representative must personally meet with the rural addresser. Upon approval, developers or subdividers at their expense, shall initially place road signs on all roads within the development or subdivision at the beginning of road and each cross road including county roads. Additionally there will be a \$10.00 ten dollar fee for each lot within the subdivision for rural addressing. This fee must be paid prior to recording of the approved plat.

Adopted this 14<sup>th</sup> day of October 1998.

This amendment is in effect on November 14 1998.
