

With current moisture in the East Mountains (EM) and autumn's cooler temperatures, pine bark

beetles are dormant by early November. Seize these opportunities to accomplish fuels mitigation and thinning work on your property before winter.

Here is the <u>90-day outlook for Tijeras</u> provided by our Vice-President Kerry Jones who worked at the Albuquerque Weather Service office, now with the Forest Service.

Free drop-off for East Mountain Green Waste Days starts this Saturday, October 25, and runs through November 9--the opportunity to haul as much slash as you can to the Tijeras transfer station, free during this time period. Everything You Wanted to Know About Bark Beetles . . .


... and a Whole Lot More You Didn't Know You Wanted to Know!
