- Agency Update-Mountainair Ranger Station, Cibola National Forrest Current conditions for fuels and fires in Area 11 are Moderate 50% or below. Red Canyon got 10" of rain this summer.

Outlooks-7-day outlook looks good

2-week temperature is normal
Precipitation is above normal
30-day outlook warmer and precipitation average

Drought conditions have gone from extreme to moderate.

Samantha said that she went to an emergency meeting, and they said that the outlook was for dryer and warmer than normal conditions.

2025 Fall/Winter Prescribed Burns: Espinoza, Thunderbird, Gallinas, Red Canyon and Pueblo Colorado.

Preparation of the Land: Modification, Survey, and Prep perimeter lines.

Drought monitoring: fire template and discuss drought conditions.
