SPECIAL MEETING

August 11th, 2020

Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Marcie Wallin.

Roll Call

Marcie Wallin called roll; members listed above were present.

1) Class Breaks

The board discussed the possibility of having less animals being pulled this year due to the cancellation of the state fair. Greg Smith previously made suggestions for breaking classes. The board talked about breaking the classes differently. Marcie Wallin asked if the board should wait to discuss sale slots until after cattle and hogs weigh in. Will Neish suggested assigning a minimum amount of sale slots for goats and sheep. The board looked at Melody Everett's suggestion for class breaks on the goats. The board agreed that exhibitors should declare whether or not animals will be in sale as soon as possible. Members predicted that the sale would include around 6 steers and 15 hogs. Johnny Perea suggested having 5 goat classes, and sell two from every class except the last one, with the grand pulling a slot. The board decided on doing that for the goat class breaks. Johnny Perea also suggested doing 6 sheep classes, selling 2 from each except for in the cross class, with the grand pulling a slot.

Motion by Johnny Perea to break classes as read. Seconded by Albert Chavez. All voted Aye.

Motion passed.

Johnny Perea asked the board about adding a rule that would not allow glue or synthetics to be used on the bodies of cattle in the show besides on their legs. The board is in agreement, and it was also added that Danny Prather would be the one to enforce the rule.

Motion by Johnny Perea to not allow glue or synthetic builders to be used on a beef, besides on the legs. Seconded by Albert Chavez. All voted Aye.

Motion passed.

Kyria Encinias asked the board if signs needed to be posted that would say that thank you baskets would not be allowed in the sale barn. The board agreed.

Motion by Albert Chavez to adjourn meeting. Seconded by Johnny Perea. All voted Aye.
